Rules for the International "Eurofotoart" Salon

VII edition, 2015

The "Euro Foto Art" International Association from Oradea is organizing with the support of the European Commission's Representation in Romania and the European Parliament Information Office in Romania, the seventh edition of the International Photographic Art Salon, under the name of EUROFOTOART 2015. The only international exhibit of this type in Europe is organized under the patronage of the Ministry of Culture and it is dedicated to celebrating Europe's Day. The exhibition will take place during the fourth edition of the European Photography Festival – Romania 2015, organized by the "Euro Foto Art" Association, with the support of the European Commission's Representation in Romania and the European Parliament Information Office in Romania and benefiting from the patronage of the Ministry of Culture.

The exhibition will be organized differently from other classic exhibitions that are organized by the International Photographic Art Federation (FIAP). As an alternative to those organized until now, during this international exhibition the jury will promote images with special artistic messages, and the prizes will be given to those images that meet the true criteria of photographic art. The organizers recommend the participants to take into account the following, during the selection of their works:

- the originality of the photographs,
- the artistic message,
- the subject of the images,
- the relation between the photographed elements,
- the elements should transmit or should represent a message,
- the shocking effect,
- the "dialogue" the image has with the ones who see it. ,

- 1 Amateur as well as professional photographers from all over the world can participate at this exhibition, with photographs made in Europe., that respect the conditions of these Rules and pay the entrance fee before the jury deliberation!
- 2 Each author will be able to participate in the Salon with 6 images for each section.
- 3 Sections of the exhibition:
 - A. Free theme
 - B. Travel
 - C. Portraits
 - D. Landscapes
- 4 Participation fee:
 - 25 euro for all sections (for European participants) or 28\$ (for participants from other continents),
 - 8 euro/section (for European participants) or 9\$ (for participants from other continents),
 - For participants over free authors, we apply a 20% discount!
 - 5\$ (for participants from the Republic of Moldova and Ukraine) or 8\$ (for participants from the P.R. China, Vietnam, India, Bangladesh), regardless of the number of submitted photographs.
 - the fees can be sent along with the CD's or via PayPal at eurofotoart.ro@gmail.com (the transfer fees are to be paid by each participant)!
- 5 The photographs can be sent digitally via:
 - E-mail: eurofotart@gmail.com
 - E-mail transfer (www.wetransfer.com)
 - Via regular mail, on a CD
- 6 The size of the file must be larger than 1MB, with the long side 3000 pixels minimum. Each photography/file will have a code which corresponds to the docket, with the title of the work. Coding the images is done as follows:
 - first letter of the title will represent the section (A, B, C, D) , a group of 4 letters (the author can chose them) the last sign will be a number, representing the sequence number entered in the section (under slip) coding groups will be separated by the symbol "-" (minus). Ex. – 1=A-AMRB thematic section free (open), Alberto, Figure 1 to Section A.
- 7 All work titles will be recorded in the docket, in English too! The docket will be filled out correctly and completely,

electronically, via e-mail europfotoart@gmail.com or on the CD – signed by the author, together with the contest works. The signature will certify that the works belong to the authors and that they are made in Europe. The organizers of the Salon are not responsible for any violations of the Romanian copyright law by the participants.

8 Incorrect or incomplete filling of the entry form will entail the exclusion of the participant from the Salon, without any refunds (the author will still receive the catalog). Exclusion from the jury process will apply in the case of non-payment in time of the fee (the author will receive the catalog after he/she has paid) .

9 Judging is done via internet, each work submitted at the Salon being given a mark from 1-10 by the jurors, without knowing the name of the authors.

10 The accepted and awarded works will enter in the collection of the Euro Foto Art Association, with the right to use them, in the interest of the Salon, if the authors agree to this. Organizers will use submitted works for publishing them in the Salon catalogue and for promoting this event in mass-media or by other advertising means. The authors of the works will retain copyrights over the accepted and awarded works.

11 The exhibition and award ceremony:

- the opening of the International Exhibition and prize ceremony will take place on Europe Day, 9 May 2015 at the “Euro Foto Art” Gallery from Oradea, Piața 1 Decembrie, no. 12.
- the exhibition will be presented in other cities .

12 The decisions of the jurors are indisputable .

13 Photographer artists that will have paid the fees filled out the entry forms correctly and fully, will receive the catalogue of the exhibition.

14 Entries can be submitted via CD or DVD Via regular mail, or priority mail:

15 The participants, who sent the images and fees, in concordance with the schedule of the event, are deemed to have accepted the conditions of the Rules for organizing the International Salon and the above stated conditions.

- Three “Carol Pop de Szathmári - Szathmári Pap Károly” Plaques (for each section)
- The “Eurofotoart” Crystal Trophy will be granted to the photographer artist that will have the most accepted and awarded entries.

The Carol Pop Szathmari medals are numbered and recorded at the State Office for Inventions and Marks of Romania

*Carol Pop Szathmari * – Karoly Pap Szathmari made the world's first photographic reportage during the Crimean War (1853 – 1865). He was born on January 11, 1812 in Cluj and named Szathmari Karoly Pap. After establishing in Bucharest (where he opened his first photography workshop) he took the name of Carol Pop Szathmari as an artist. For his photographic work, he has received honor from the Queen of England, the Emperor of Austria, from Napoleon III of France and the King of Spain.*
